The Word Proskuneo: is translated as worship for Jehovah 22 times in the New World translation. The same Greek word when applied to Jesus is translated; Obeisance, Reverence, and Homage, to distort the actual worship accepted by Jesus Christ.

Leper Worshipped Him

25 "And the rain descended, and the floods came, and the winds blew, and burst against that house; and yet it did not fall, for it had been founded upon the rock.
