Blue Letter Bible is a nonprofit corporation, recognized by the state of California as a religious, charitable organization; further recognized by the Internal Revenue Service as a section 501(c)(3) public charity. Our EIN is 47-2951572. All donations to the ministry are tax deductible to the fullest extent of the law. The ministry was organized as an independent non-profit organization on November 1, 2016.

As a recognized 501(c)(3) charitable organization, Blue Letter Bible is bound by the rules and regulatory requirements as set forth by the law. Primary oversight of our organization has been entrusted to our Board of Directors, which consists of 9 members; 6 of which are independent, non-related persons. The Board of Directors is charged with making all decisions regarding major purchases and expenditures, salaries of officers, and ministerial direction. The board, with its independent make up majority, helps maintain a necessary measure of accountability. Day-to-day operational decisions are handled by the President/CEO, Jim Milligan and the COO, Andy Guastaferro.

Our desire is to be as financially transparent as possible. To that end, our federal 990 tax filings are available for public inspection upon request. We are actively pursuing membership with the Evangelical Council for Financial Accountability (ECFA), and our annual financial statement audits are done by an outside accounting firm.

The support we receive is used to provide powerful tools for an in-depth study of God's Word through our free online reference library, with study tools that are grounded in the historical, conservative Christian faith. The leaders of the ministry continually seek the Lord when considering new ways to fulfill the mission entrusted to us. As the Lord direct and provides, we follow.
