


Debi said...

This newly structured text allows for ease of reading and facilitates more than 60,000 instant verse retrievals, making precious study time in the Scriptures more proficient. BLB has uniquely formatted this unabridged version in a user friendly outline that renders a pop-up view of all Bible references, eliminating the need to leave the commentary page in order to read the verses. New Study Guides in Spanish From Pastor David Guzik


