

# Passing on a Love for God's Word to the Next Generation with BLB

2 Timothy 2:2 reads, "And the things which you have heard from me in the presence of many witnesses, these entrust to faithful men, who will be able to teach others also." The apostle Paul had a vision for four generations who would pass on the precious truths of God's Word, after first internalizing these words for themselves. We at BLB would like you to meet Thomas Purtell, a man whom God has graciously used to enact this model for discipleship. Way back in 2002, a friend told Thomas about BLB's website. At first. Thomas doubted what he was hearing. A place to access various translations and other Bible resources, all for free? But when he checked it out, he says "I was blown away." He considered BLB an amazing gift to the body of Christ.

As the years went by, Thomas and BLB grew together. He used the website to prepare for the studies he taught and the messages he



was invited to preach. The lexicon, interlinear Greek with English translations, encyclopedias, and dictionaries all became invaluable tools in his preparation.

But what really got our attention was that Thomas developed a plan for passing on his expertise. Crucial to this effort was the BLB app. Five years ago, Thomas took aside his 13-year-old son and told him that the first app he needed to put on his phone was BLB's. In Thomas's words.

It takes fifteen seconds to download, and a lifetime to upload.

Further, each week he went over one of the app's resources with his son, making sure that he knew how to use it. In this way, his son became competent to study God's Word for himself.

But the process did not stop there! Soon a friend of Thomas's asked whether Thomas might mentor his son in how to use the BLB resources. Before long, a whole group of young men were meeting in a restaurant to receive tutorials on using our app. What a priceless gift to put in their hands! Thomas understood that you do not need to be a scholar to handle God's Word accurately, and that teenagers are a prime audience for what BLB has to offer.

We can see how Thomas's familiarity with BLB has allowed him to live out 2 Timothy 2:2. What he received from a friend, he has passed on to the next generation. And what can he expect? # New Scripture Images to Download and Share—For Free




"Boardies" are videos addressing difficult to understand or commonly misunderstood passages in the Bible, while "Summaries" are
